### Iconic Vitranc Cup for the 64th consecutive year - the highlight of winter in Kranjska Gora

It was 1962 when the first competitors descended the course from the top of the Vitranc to the foot of the hill at the upstream part of the Sava Dolinka River. The FIS Alpine Ski World Cup caravan stopped in Kranjska Gora for the first time 6 years later, in March 1968.

Since then, the Alpine Ski World Cup in Kranjska Gora has developed into one of the largest, best organised and best-attended sporting events in Slovenia as well as internationally. In recent years, the race course in Podkoren has also gained its place in the Women's Alpine Ski World Cup. It is only thanks to the hard-working and persistent ski enthusiasts, brought together by the local ski club

ASK Kranjska Gora, who have devoted hours of their time to the World Cup races with their dedication and professionalism, that Kranjska Gora will continue to host Alpine Ski World Cup races for at least the next 10 years.





# **NEW DEVELOP-MENTS IN 2025**


We are taking the spectators' experience of competition and entertainment to a new level.

Party, party, party. The level of fun at the Alpine Ski World Cup in Kranjska Gora will exceed all expectations this year.

First, Fehtarji, currently the most popular folk music band in Slovenia, will ensure the dynamics between the first and second runs of Saturday's giant slalom, and then, for the second year in a row, Slovenia's biggest après ski will take over the evening programme, this year performed by DeeJay Time Back in Time Carnival with two top bands, Croatia's Karma and Germany's Groove Coverage. The Après Ski party, which is unashamedly called the Slovenia's biggest Après Ski party, will also feature Dean on The Mike and Dr. Silvano DJ, who will conjure up a real musical adventure at the turn of the millennium. The traditional prize giving ceremony for Saturday's giant slalom and the bib draw for Sunday's slalom will be, as every year, something special. On Sunday, between the two slalom runs, Natalia Verboten, the gueen of traditional pop, will warm our hands and feet with her dance rhythms.

This year, spectators in the VIP grandstand will have the opportunity to watch the race from the spacious terrace, which extends into the immediate vicinity of the race course and offers a spectacular view of the final slope, where the most important hundredths of seconds are chased. The Vitranc Cup will be even better than ever before, and that is why it is the highlight of winter in Slovenia and the surrounding countries every year.



# **Pokal Vitranc** #funfacts



- The previous finish of the racecourse was located next to today's petrol station between Podkoren and Kranjska Gora; a part of the course (clearing) is still visible today.
- 88 World Cup competitions have been carried out within the Vitranc Cup (46 GSL, 41 SL, 1 ladies' SL), 11 European Cup competitions (3 GSL and 8 SL) and 20 FIS competitions at various levels.
- Kranjska Gora has carried out 5 replacement World Cup races for men, which have been cancelled in other World Cup locations.







- Most Vitranc Cup winners, 22, have so far come from Austria, which also has the most wins in both slalom and giant slalom.
- As many as 51 competitors from 14 different countries have won the Vitranc Cup up to now.
- Most wins were achieved by Ted Ligety (USA) and Marcel Hirscher (AUT), namely 6. Ligety achieved all his wins in giant slalom.
- Most ranks among the best first three competitors were achieved by Marcel Hirscher (AUT), namely 15.
- The worst winning percentage among the skiers who were placed among the three best skiers and actually took the first place, goes to Marcel Hirscher (AUT), who won six times, but was placed among the top three as many as 15 times.
- The longest period between the first and last win was recorded by Ivica Kostelić (CRO), who first won in 2003 and the second time, which was also the last time, in 2013.



- Standing on the Vitranc Cup winners' podium were also two brothers: Mario Matt (AUT) won in 2009 and 2011, while his younger brother Michael Matt (AUT) won the slalom in 2017.
- The shortest time difference between the winner and the runner-up was in the giant slalom in 1970, where Mauro Bernardi (ITA) and Hans Enn (AUT) shared the first place.
- The shortest time difference ever recorded in slalom was in 1990, when Jonas Nilsson (SWE) beat Hubert Strolz (AUT) by 0.01 seconds.
- The longest time difference between the first and second ranked was recorded in the 1961 slalom, when Ernst Falsch (AUT) defeated Josef Stiegler (AUT) by 3.10 seconds.
- The longest time difference between the first and second in the giant slalom was 2.50 seconds in the same year - Josef Stiegler (AUT) beat Joseph Behr (GER).
- Most wins on the home snow were achieved by Bojan Križaj (SLO) – 4 in total, 3 in slalom and one in giant slalom.

- As many as 15 times was the difference between the first and second ranked higher than 1 second (4 times in slalom and 11 times in giant slalom).
- As many as 14 times, was the difference between the first and the second ranked less than one-tenth of a second (5 times in slalom, and 9 times in giant slalom).
- Bojan Križaj (SLO) also achieved the most placements on the winners' podium among all Slovenian skiers – 6 times.
- Jure Košir (SLO) was the last Slovenian skier to win the Vitranc Cup on home snow on 6th January 1999.
- The last Slovenian skier to be standing on the podium on 'home snow' was Uroš Pavlovčič on the replacement giant slalom (cancelled race in Aspen), on 20th December 2001.
- The tallest skier to win the Vitranc Cup is Ramon Zenhäusern with 200 cm.

The event combines both the classic 10km run from the squere in front of the Razor Hotel in Kranjska Gora, as well as a children's run, where children can compete in a 400m run.

#### TRIGLAV TRAIL RUN, 22<sup>nd</sup> to 24<sup>th</sup> August 2025

The Triglav Trail Run is more than just a run around Triglav. It is a gathering of runners, mountain runners in search of fresh running content and new experiences. The Triglav Trail Run brings together a variety of running and mountain activities and events that excite and unite runners. mountaineers and, above all, mountain lovers.

#### **JULIAN ALPS TRAIL RUN,** 19<sup>th</sup> to 21<sup>st</sup> September 2025

The Julian Alps Trail Run is Slovenia's largest trail running event, which in 2022 become a part of the elite UTMB® World series. Participants have the opportunity to experience the stunning natural beauty of the region, while at the same time strengthening themselves physically and mentally. With its rugged terrain and stunning scenery, the Julian Alps Trail Run is a mustdo event for running enthusiasts looking for a physical and visual adventure.

#### **IXS EUROPEAN DOWNHILL CUP** 26th to 28th September 2025

Kranjska Gora is an important cycling destination in summer. After last year's Slovenian 20chocolate Downhill Cup, Kranjska Gora will become the venue for the European Downhill Cup in 2025. Kranjska Gora already hosted European Cup races between 2015 and 2019. This time, however, it will not host just any race, but the final race on the last weekend in September, when the winners of the series will be crowned under the Vitranc mountain.


